Entries close on **Friday 30 September 2011 at 5.00 pm** or when a capacity field is reached. **An entry form will not be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee.** Late entries may be accepted if a vacancy exists.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Magpies Belconnen Golf Club (MBGC) Championships is open to male financial members of the MBGC (including juniors) with a valid and current Golf Australia handicap. Entries will be accepted from 6 Day members subject to the conditions set out at page 7 of the 2009-2010 'Handbook'. The maximum handicap for this event is 36. **Please note that if your handicap changes as a result of your score in any of the first three rounds you MUST record your original handicap and your changed handicap on your score card for any subsequent round. Your handicap for the overall event remains the same as the handicap you commenced the Championship with, and your new handicap is used for the day competition.**
2. Starting times are 0700-1000 and 1100-1230 on Saturdays and Sunday 9 October. Seeded draw will be conducted on the final day Sunday 16 October commencing with C Grade, followed by B Grade, A Grade then Juniors.
3. Every effort will be made to place participants in their preferred starting times with preferred playing partners. Preferred starting times will be allocated in order of Entry Form receipt. Late entries may be accepted if vacancies exist. The entry form will not be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee.
4. Entries will close on Friday 30 September 2011 at 5.00 pm, or when a capacity field is reached.
5. The Championships will be conducted in A Grade for players on handicaps of 14 or less, B Grade for players on handicaps of 15 to 21, and C Grade for players on handicaps of 22 or more. The Junior Championships is for players on any handicap but who are under 21 years of age on 8 October 2011. Please note juniors will compete in the Junior Division only but are eligible to win the overall Club Championship (best gross score) as indeed are all entrants irrespective of grade.
6. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as recognised by Golf Australia, and the MBGC Local Rules. Penalties for slow play may be applied.
7. Players are requested to report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their designated Tee Time.
8. The MBGC Match Committee shall have the power to vary any conditions and to determine any dispute or question arising as to the disqualification of any entrant and may, at its absolute discretion at any time and without assigning reason therefore, refuse entry or declare any entrant ineligible to compete.
9. In the event of a tie in the Club Championship, the winner will be decided by a three hole playoff on holes 1, 9 and 18, immediately after completion of play in the final round. If scores are still tied after the three hole playoff, a sudden death play-off on the 18th hole will be held until a winner is determined. Players not present to contest the play-off will be declared ineligible for the play-off and forfeit their right to contest the playoff. All other events will be decided by count back as prescribed by Golf Australia.
10. Gross results take precedence over nett results. A competitor is entitled to win only one daily prize each day, and one Championship prize overall.
11. **Cancellation and refunds:** No refunds will be made for any cancellation received less than 7 days prior to the event except that cancellations on medical grounds or incapacity will be given consideration.
